NFPA 70E TRAINING

This course provides an overview of the use and arrangement of the NFPA 70E-2018 Standard for Electrical Safety in the Workplace. *The course is broken into two sections: the first section (a full day) centers on electrical worker safety on the job and the second section (a half day) focuses on employer responsibilities under NFPA. Participants may attend either the full day, half day, or both sections.* Participants will discuss elements of an electrical safety program, as well as electrical hazards, guidelines to energized vs. de-energized work and decision making. Topics will also include the 8 steps to an ESWC, selection and application of appropriate PPE, and the supervisor’s responsibility for jobsite safety. Following this course, participants will be able to:

- Identify concepts and requirements contained in NFPA 70E-2018
- Describe the generally recognized hazard of electrical work
- Discuss the needed personal protective equipment within arc flash and arc blast boundaries
- Discuss potential electrical hazards in the workplace
- Explain the supervisor’s responsibility to jobsite safety

About the instructor: Derek Vigstol is the Senior Electrical Content Specialist for NFPA technical services. He serves as a technical resource for the development and implementation of supporting products to NFPA electrical codes and standards. Derek joined NFPA in 2015 as a Senior Electrical Specialist where he assisted in the code and standard development process for multiple NFPA electrical documents. He also served as the Electrical Technical Lead for NFPA prior to NFPA creating the role of a content specialist. Prior to joining NFPA, he was an instructor at the Minneapolis Electrical Joint Apprenticeship Training Center and a licensed master electrician in the state of Minnesota.
